\$300.00 fee for wedding rehearsal and ceremony, includes consultation(s) to discuss and finalize music selections.

Any rehearsals for musicians/soloists in addition to the wedding rehearsal are \$50.00.

*** If the couple uses the Parish Hall for a reception, double this amount if the sexton is requested for setup.

When do I pay? (for non-parishioners)

(this does not include the Parish Hall, which is to be reserved and paid for separately)

- Deposit \$100 before date reserved - *this goes towards Discretionary Fund*
- \$200 due 1 month before date of wedding - *this goes towards church fee*
- Balance due at wedding rehearsal

How do I pay?

- The organist, sexton, and acolytes are paid separately and with either cash or by check made out to CASH.
- If paying the Officiant by check it should be made out to Rev. Charles Kramer.
- If paying the discretionary fund by check it should be made out to Rector's Discretionary Fund.
- All other checks are payable to St. James Episcopal Church and write the wedding name and wedding date on memo.
