## When do I pay? (for non-parishioners)

(this does not include the Parish Hall, which is to be reserved and paid for separately)

- Deposit \$100 before date reserved this goes towards Discretionary Fund
- \$200 due 1 month before date of wedding this goes towards church fee
- Balance due at wedding rehearsal

## How do I pay?

- The organist, sexton, and acolytes are paid separately and with either cash or by check made out to CASH.
- If paying the Officiant by check it should be made out to them.
- If paying the discretionary fund by check it should be made out to <u>Rector's Discretionary Fund</u>.
- All other checks are payable to <u>St. James Episcopal Church</u> and write the wedding name and wedding date on memo.
